



All the activities mentioned in the stay description are offered to the children, regardless of their level. The sports activities are conducted under the responsibility of specialized instructors who oversee the discipline of their expertise and know how to adapt it from beginner to advanced levels.


The necessary equipment is always provided (helmets, pony helmets, life vests, etc.). This equipment is modern, wellmaintained, and checked at each stay.

No activity is mandatory, but the role of the staff is to encourage children to participate.

The instructors have a good level in their discipline to ensure that children can discover and progress safely. The artistic activities are designed and supervised by the instructors to allow the children to develop their creative sensitivity.

We only exceptionally call upon external providers for the activities, as we prefer the children to be supervised by our teams who know them well and follow them throughout their stay. Thus, in small groups, the pace is adapted to each child's desires, needs, and fatigue level.

The majority of activities take place at our centers to avoid long travel times by bus or minibus.


